

Pastor Peter Video Transcript

Pastor Peter: My name is Pastor Peter Mayon. I am saved, I love Jesus. I am the Pastor at Nalepo Baptist Church On the Mountain. I am married, I have one wife, and we are blessed with two daughters and are happy.

Daniel: What did you learn about being a husband? How many wives do you have?

Pastor Peter: [laughs] Only one wife. I have learned, as a man of one wife, that we should help each other and serve one another.

Daniel: And loving her?

Pastor Peter: [laughs] Yes, of course. Loving her more.

Daniel: People were asking this issue of washing the dishes...in the Masaai culture, that may be hard but how else can you help your wife?

Pastor Peter: I will help my wife, especially knowing that I am a Christian, even if it means I wash those dishes!

Daniel: What will you tell the team that brought the training?

Pastor Peter: I want to say a big thank you and blessings upon the team that made this possible. We hope for more teachings. I pray that God gives them wisdom and knowledge to continue with the good work.
